Introduction

The 2012 Magnolia conference will wrap up with a full day focused on the Magnolia community.

The day will combine an unconference with a single track of formal presentations. The event will happen at the same location as the rest of the 2012 Magnolia Conference.

What's an unconference?

An unconference is an event where the participants propose sessions and design the schedule. This is quite different from traditional conferences where the organization team chooses speakers, designs the schedule and manages the event.

Another key feature of unconferences is that most of the sessions tend to be free discussions between peers, rather than formal presentations made by an individual. Unconferences work best when the participants have a lot of skill or interest in the topics being discussed.

People who have participated in [BarCamp](#) or [Open Space Technology](#) events will be familiar with the unconference format. For more information, read the Wikipedia article on [unconferences](#).

Open to conference attendees

The Community Day is open to Magnolia conference attendees. To participate in the day, **you must be registered for the 2012 Magnolia conference**. This wiki space is only for coordinating sessions for the unconference and sharing information about the day.
