Common Properties

These properties can be used with any auditor:

name	required The name of the auditor, usually the node name (either from JCR or YAML configuration). It's important that each auditor have a unique name among all configured auditors. Auditors will save some results by their name.
description	required A short description of the auditor. The description be displayed when selecting audits.
active	required Defines if the auditor is active. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• AuditPageAction - only executes active auditors, inactive auditors are skipped.• FlexiAuditPageAction - allows users to select what auditors are run and both active and inactive auditors can be selected.
