

Upgrading environments - rules

This feature is available in the Cockpit, under the "Install an update" part.

Upgrade Magnolia



Change the version of Magnolia used in your environments

Upgrade Magnolia and benefit from the newest features available in your Integration, UAT or Live environments. Restore your previous upgrade. Delete the upgrade backup to be able to tear down the environment

It is possible to perform an upgrade across different bundle types. If you don't see your new bundle in your package even though you followed the rules below, contact HD and ask them for checking bundle types upgrade configuration.

Upgrading rules



Term

Bundle type = bundle group id + bundle artifact id

- If two bundles have the same bundle type, the new bundle must have a later version.
- If two bundles have different bundle types, the bundles must have different bundle artifact versions. This is a limitation of Facade.
- After upgrade, the upgrade backup can be deleted (created only in the Live environment). However, it can be restored only if the current instances of the given environment are NOT in the "Termination protection" mode.
